Basic surgical skills - WHO

Suction is used to clear the surgical field by removing blood or other fluids. The suction tip is attached to a vacuum piping outside of the sterile field. Types of surgical procedure. Open surgery is the most common type of surgery and characterised by the staples or stitches used to close the incision. Keyhole surgery is done through very small incisions in a patient's skin with the use of a fine tube with a light on the end (known as a fibre optic light source). The surgeon carries out the operation by using special instruments inserted through the tube.
